

Community & Tribal Guidelines and Eligibility

Desert Diamond Casinos & Entertainment considers requests for community outreach donations from only two types of organizations:

- 1. Non-profit charitable organizations classified as 501-C
- 2. Tohono O'odham Nation organizations.

Additional guidelines include:

- Individuals, for-profit organizations or 3rd party organizations will not be considered by Desert Diamond Casinos & Entertainment.
- Organizations may only submit one request in a 12 month period (October September)
- Deadlines for submissions are the 10th of each month. If a request is received after the 10th it will be reviewed the following month.
- Requests must be received at least 3 months prior to the event. If there are printing needs, the request must be received at least 5 months prior to the event.
- Areas of focus that Desert Diamond Casinos & Entertainment will consider include: health care, education, arts & culture, community, seniors and youth.
- Applications must include the following documents to be considered:

Non-Profit Organizations

- Community Support Form
- Copy of Proof of non-profit status (501-C designation letter from the IRS)
- W-9 Form
- Supplementary materials optional

Tribal Organizations

- Tribal Support Form
- Copy of Proof of non-profit status, such as a 501-C designation letter from the IRS, Tribal Council Resolution or other document of status as a non-profit charitable organization.
- (If unable to provide proof of non-profit status, please complete and submit the Application for a Tohono O'odham Charitable Organization form)
- Proof of services provided are on the Nation and/or benefits tribal members
- W-9 Form
- Supplementary materials optional
